Memorial to Host Free Seminar, Screenings for Wound Healing Center

SPRINGFIELD – Memorial Medical Center is hosting two free community events in August as part of the two-year anniversary of its [Wound Healing Center](#).

Dr. Michael Neumeister, medical director of Memorial’s Wound Healing Center, will lead a free lunch-and-learn session titled “My Wound Won’t Heal – What Can I Do?” from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 11, in the hospital’s Wedeberg Conference Center.

The session will be of particular interest to people who are suffering from or have family members suffering from chronic, non-healing wounds or wounds that haven’t healed in 30 days.

Memorial’s Wound Healing Center will also offer free blood pressure and blood sugar screenings from 9-11 a.m. Thursday, Aug. 12. The center is also open to the community for tours of the state-of-the-art facility, and prize drawings will be held throughout the event.
